7. Speakers

Steve Parr – Community Safety Sergeant, Devon & Cornwall Police

Steve introduced himself and said he works with CCTV, licensing department, Youth Intervention, Crime Prevention and Neighbourhood Watch.

Steve showed the group the pick pocket bells in a catalogue of wholesale security goods. They can be purchased for 28p each +VAT with a minimum order of 100. The group were very keen to have these bells and Steve said he may be able to obtain a small number for the group.

Steve also showed the group personal attack alarms with a torch that can be carried or clipped onto bags or clothing. These sell at £3 each via Neighbourhood Watch. Bicycle chains and padlock sell for £4 and alarmed padlocks which are good for sheds and motorbike chains sell at £12. Other things that can be purchased from Neighbourhood Watch include Door alarms, spy holes and security chains. All items are at heavily discounted prices.

The group liked the personal attack alarms and Stuart Cullimore said he would happily fund a number of these for the group out of his pot of money. However he would need to see a copy of the groups constitution. LC to bring to next meeting

The group were delighted at this and will now set about being a stand alone group with their own bank account so they can receive this funding and be in apposition to apply for other funding
