



## **FUNDING PROGRAMMES AT THE CORNWALL COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (CCF)**

These are the current CCF Funds available to 'not for profit' organisations and individuals in Cornwall the Isles of Scilly as at 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2010.

Restrictions do apply to each. For full details please refer to the appropriate grant guidelines. Examples of the types of projects funded for each programme can be provided if required.

### **Active at 60**

The Active at 60 Project aims to assist those people who are moving into retirement stay active, independent and positively engaged with society, particularly those most at risk of loneliness and social isolation in later life. The project aims to do this through Active at 60 Community Agents.

Grants from £250 to £3,000

### **BBC Radio Cornwall Appeal Fund**

Grants for the benefit of organisations and causes which bring people together in their local community.

### **Benefiting Older People Fund**

Awards are granted to support projects that improve the quality of life of older people specifically increasing access to services, helping to regain confidence & self esteem and encouraging older people to participate in activities which bring communities together.

Grants from £250 - £500

### **Caradon Area Community Fund (CACF)**

Created to provide a sustainable source of funding that will meet the needs of existing and future grass root community and voluntary groups and projects working to improve people's lives in the Caradon area. The purpose of the Fund is to offer opportunities to grass roots community and voluntary groups in the Caradon area to receive small grants so they may create and/or deliver projects for the benefit of their community and members via a simple, effective, inclusive programme.

Grants range from £250 to £500

## **City of London Bursary Fund**

Under the umbrella of Lord Lieutenant's Fund for Youth, The City of London Bursary Fund aims to help young people residing in Cornwall who have demonstrated the desire and capability to accomplish great things in Higher Education but who are in danger of being held back by personal or family hardship, or disability.

Awards are made and decided upon through the 4 participating organisations Falmouth, Truro and Cornwall Colleges and Exeter University at Tremough.

For beneficiaries up to 25 years old.

## **Cornwall 100 Club Fund**

Grants are aimed at small, community and voluntary groups throughout the County for projects which address any number of 7 themes - transport, poverty and crisis, older people, communities and local environment, young people, disabled and minority groups e.g. migrant workers & travellers.

Awards will typically range from £500 to £5,000

## **Cornwall Garden Society Fund**

Grants are made to people who have demonstrated a desire and capacity to accomplish great things in the field of gardening and horticulture but who are in danger of being held back by personal or family hardship or disability.

Applications are currently only received from the two participating colleges; University College Falmouth and Duchy College, Rosewarne for their current students. Min. age of 17 years

The maximum grant is £3,000 however most range between £200 - £1,000 with a current average of £650.

## **Crisis Fund (previously known as the Bishop's Fund)**

Grants are made to charitable organisations and agencies such as Citizen's Advice Bureau's, refuges, homeless and church groups, to benefit people in crisis who are urgently in need of small, one off amounts of money.

Top-ups of £250 are awarded to these organisations who issue grants at their discretion up to £75

## **High Sheriff's & Safer Communities Fund**

Supports initiatives that aim to reduce crime and anti social behaviour with youth led projects and co-ordinated activities for young people.

Grants from £250 - £1,000 with an average award of £500

## **Lord and Lady St Levan Fund**

The main purpose of this fund is for the relief of hardship and poverty and for education of Cornish people. A small proportion would be payable for cultural and musical purposes. Additionally a small proportion could be used for medical research.

Grants range up to £10,000 (in exceptional circumstances)

Grants up to £1,000

## **Lord Lieutenant's Fund for Youth**

The Lord Lieutenant's Fund for Youth aims to help young people who have demonstrated the desire and capability to accomplish great things – in the field of sport, the arts, voluntary service, science or enterprise, amongst other possibilities – and who have demonstrated outstanding and clearly recognised abilities but who are in danger of being held back by personal or family hardship, or disability.

For beneficiaries up to 25 years old

Grants up to £5,000 with a current average award of £800

## **Morwenna Fund**

This Fund is for the benefit of a single parent or carer, living alone with a child/children who is experiencing need, hardship or distress, in particular single parents.

Grants are awarded to sponsors on behalf of their beneficiaries. Sponsors include health visitors, doctors, teachers, CAB, police, Children's Centres and representatives from voluntary agencies.

Grants from £50 - £250

## **Police Property Fund**

Applications are invited from local voluntary groups who are working with their local Neighbourhood Beat Manager, Police Community Support Officer to improve the lives of people in their community. The main purpose of the fund is to help improve public confidence in the police and their partners and the way they deal with issues that matter to the local community.

Examples of projects could include protective clothing for a litter picking project, or paint for a graffiti wall.

Grants from £250 - £1000

## Truro College Fund

Truro College's Fund aims to help their students alleviate disadvantage and difficulties with financial help. Full details are available from the College direct.
