5. **Matter Arising from the Minutes of the Last Meeting:**

## **6. Speakers**

**Andy Bartle** – Highways Cornwall Council &

**Stuart Cullimore** – Town Councillor and Cornwall Councillor

The continued issues of resident parking in the Tolcarne Street were discussed. Andy explained that a Resident Parking Scheme would cost between £20k and £50k.

Residents would need to do consultation to get the views from all local residents. Most resident parking schemes get kicked out as there is often not enough local support for the scheme. An average cost for residents to be part of this scheme is £55.00 per year which is costly and currently there is no funding available for this type of scheme.

Implementing disabled parking bays – Andy mentioned that their may be a solution to this. The completed disabled bay applications could be piggybacked onto an existing traffic regulation order with draft legal documents e.g. if a yellow lines order has been put in then you could piggy back the disabled bay applications onto this order therefore not incurring any additional legal fees.

You need to think about what is suitable and put in an application for a disabled bay. You need to be aware that any disabled person will be able to park there. There could be a 6-9 months minimum waiting.

The Glebe parking issues – people are parking in The Glebe and walking into town to work. Stuart invited members of the group and Coastline staff to attend a meeting at the Glebe on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2011 at 3:30pm. Stuart is hoping to get support from the town council after this meeting to try and address the issues.

Stuart also has access to a small 'Community Chest' funding pot. Any community group can apply to the pot for funding but the project must be based in the Camborne South area. Groups to
