Specific Accountabilities – The Brass Tacks

In the role, day to day, you'll be responsible for:

1. Assisting the Painting and Repairs Supervisor in the day to day running of the Painting and Repairs team;
2. Carrying out refurbishment works, painting and decorating as required under the instruction of your Supervisor or Deputy Supervisor;
3. Undertaking all duties in accordance with HSE and Coastline Health and Safety policies and procedures;
4. Coastline vehicles and equipment which are within your possession or care;
5. Participating in, and occasionally leading on, Tool Box Talks;
6. Completing all mandatory training, risk assessments and other activities as required by Coastline;
7. Representing yourself in a professional, courteous and competent manner at all times, wearing your Coastline uniform, ID and appropriate PPE;
8. Deputising for the Supervisor when they are absent, on holiday or away, ensuring that:
 - Works are carried out in a safe manner,
 - H&S policy, regulations and best practice and company values and rules are adhered to,
 - Members of the team, are trained, supported and benefiting from your knowledge and skills,
 - Sub-Contractors are working to the required Coastline standard,
 - The rest of the management team are aware of progress, issues and problems,
 - Images and information are provided to assist with the accurate pricing of jobs,
 - Any other duties that might reasonably be required while the Supervisor is absent.
