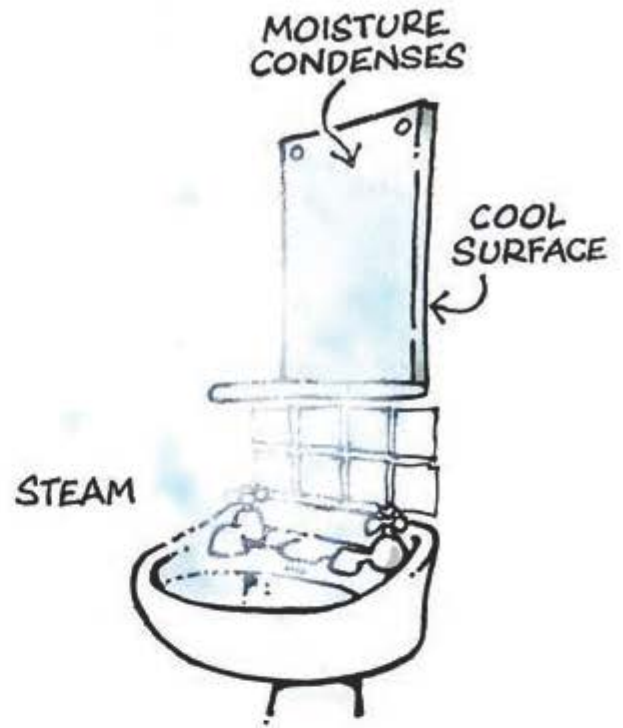
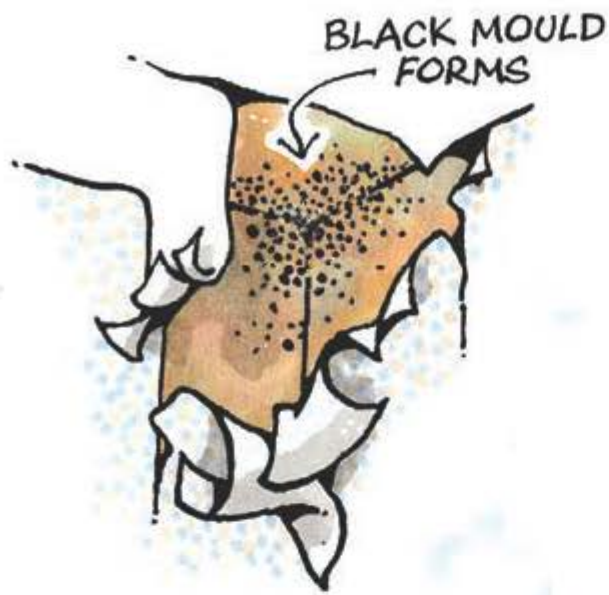
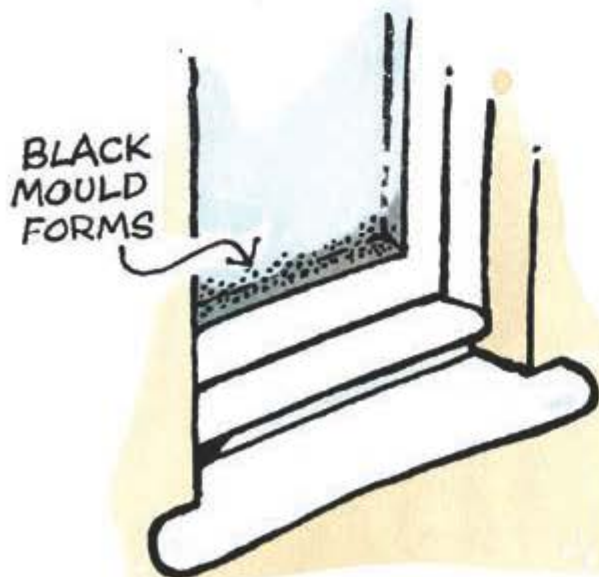


Condensation, damp and mould
